Proposed BCC Bylaws Changes will be voted on at the Jan. 15, 2013 BCC Meeting

The BCC board has proposed four changes to the bylaws to reflect actual current

operations and to improve efficiency of operations in the future. The changes will be voted on by members attending the January 15, 2013 BCC meeting.

The proposed changes are:

- 1. Membership dues will be decided by the board rather than being stated in the bylaws. (The board has decided to not increase dues in 2013.)
- 2. The dates of member meetings will be decided by the board rather than being stated in the bylaws.
- 3. Checks may be signed by either the Treasurer or the President, and the board will establish financial control procedures to safeguard funds.
- 4. Communication to members may be by either electronic or paper communication.

The intention of these changes is to update the bylaws to reflect current practice and to allow administrative changes without going through the cumbersome process of changing the bylaws.

The board urges a yes vote on these changes.
