HELP MAKE 1ST AVE NW/N 137 ST INTERSECTION SAFER: 10 ACCIDENTS SINCE 2005*

Outdated + dangerous intersection unsafe for growing neighborhood







Looking at these images toward the intersection, one can see that visibility to adjacent streets in very limited due to mature vegetation and fencing.

- Narrow sightlines and overgrown vegetation makes visibility poor.
- 1st ave NW only uninterrupted north/south route between 132nd/143.
 Heavily used by children and families walking to Broadview Thomson School/Churches/Library and a favorite for bicyclists.
- 137th connects from 8th Ave NW to Aurora cars routinely cut through here and cannot see 1st Ave NW until on 1st Ave NW, which is too late.
- Seattle has a streets/parks improvement fund that is taking applications (http://www.seattle.gov/neighborhoods/programs-and-services/your-voice-yourchoice/get-involved).
- Applying for an engineered safety solution to make the intersection safer.
- Community support was <u>critical</u> to previous projects getting funded/done. Please contact me by January 26th if you'd like to help!
